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ABOUT JMS

Joint Medical Store (JMS) is the leading Private Not-for-Profit Organization (PNFP) established in 1979 by Uganda Catholic Medical Bureau (UCMB) and Uganda Protestant Medical Bureau (UPMB) as a body Corporate under the Trustees Incorporation Act (Cap 165).

JMS is licensed by National Drug Authority (NDA) to engage in the importation, warehousing, exportation, wholesale and distribution of medicines and related healthcare supplies. JMS also engages in other health commodity value chain activities including but not limited to training of health workers, infrastructure development, repair and maintenance of medical equipment, and institutional development.

The National Medicines Policy 2015-2020 recognizes JMS as the mandated warehouse for all faith-based PNFP Health facilities. In undertaking this role, JMS works with a range of partners and stakeholders including but not limited to the Government of Uganda through the Ministry of Health, Development Partners, suppliers, investors, service providers, and customers to enhance critical supply chain needs in Uganda.

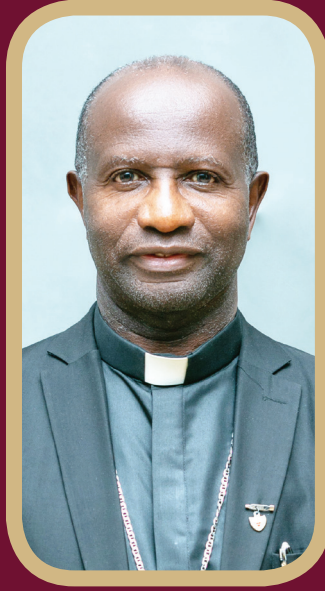
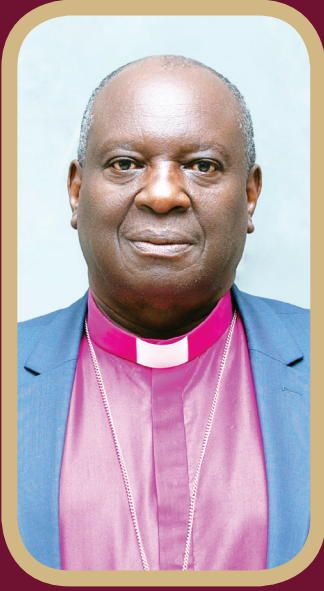

GOVERNANCE

JMS operates as a private not-for-profit organization governed by the Trustees Incorporation Act with a well-functioning governance system, consisting of an Annual General Meeting, Board of Trustees that advises the organization at the highest levels, and a Board of Directors that oversees various committees (Technical, Management, Finance, Procurement and Audit).

The Trustees and the Directors are appointed by the medical Bureaux each with equal representation. The JMS Trustees, Board and management follow charters that compel JMS to act in the best interest of the organization while protecting its assets, promoting the welfare of staff and preserving the integrity of the organization. Possible decisions are investigated and their impact on the organization and the one that best suits the interests of the organization is chosen.

JMS has Standard Operating Procedures and Policies that prescribe the steps for critical storage and distribution activities such as inventory receiving, physical inventory, internal audit, storage, cold chain handling, and

pharmaceutical waste disposal. We conduct both periodic and ad hoc internal audits to verify compliance to statutory, regulatory, and relevant ISO requirements. External audits are conducted by certified public accountants, the National Drug Authority, ISO-certified quality management system auditors, and International Development Partners such as USAID, and Global Fund to verify compliance to requirements and contractual obligations. The audits are used for continual improvements, contractual management and regulatory licensing. JMS has a number of financial controls in place outlined in the Financial Manual and related policies. These outline procedures and boundaries for cash management, expenditure approvals, bank reconciliation, budget control, receivables and payables management, inventory management, fixed assets management, operating ratios and financial statements.

JMS has an Internal audit department and external auditors appointed by the Annual General Meeting to ensure that the above responsibilities are met.
